

Submission Guidelines for Authors

1. Scope and Eligibility

3. Manuscript Preparation

3.1 Language

Manuscripts must be written in clear, grammatically correct English or Hindi.

Authors whose native language is not English are encouraged to seek professional language editing prior to submission.

3.2 Document Format

- File format: MS Word (.doc or .docx)
 - Page size: A4
 - Layout: Single-column
 - Font: Standard academic font (e.g., Times New Roman / Roboto)

3.3 Manuscript Structure

Manuscripts should be arranged in the following order:

1. Title
 2. Author name(s) and affiliation(s)
 3. Corresponding author details
 4. Abstract (150–250 words)
 5. Keywords (3–6)
 6. Introduction
 7. Literature Review (if applicable)
 8. Methodology
 9. Results and Discussion
 10. Conclusion
 11. Acknowledgements (optional)
 12. Funding Statement (if applicable)
 13. Conflict of Interest Declaration
 14. References

3.4 Abstract and Keywords

- Abstract should clearly state objectives, methodology, results, and conclusions.
 - Abstract must not contain references.
 - Provide 3–6 relevant keywords.

3.5 Tables, Figures, and Illustrations

- Tables and figures must be numbered consecutively.
- Each must have a clear caption.
- Images must be of high resolution
- Sources must be acknowledged.

4. Referencing Style

The journal follows **APA 7th Edition** referencing style.

4.1 In-Text Citations

- One author: (Sharma, 2022)
- Two authors: (Sharma & Verma, 2023)
- Three or more authors: (Sharma et al., 2023)

4.3 Reference Quality

Authors must ensure that all references are complete, accurate, and verifiable. References with missing essential information may be returned for correction.

5. Ethical Requirements

All submissions must comply with the journal's ethical policies.

Authors must ensure:

- No plagiarism
- No duplicate submission
- Proper authorship attribution
- Ethical approval where applicable
- Accurate data reporting

Misconduct may result in rejection or retraction.

6. Required Documents

Authors must submit the following documents along with the manuscript:

- Author Declaration Form
- Copyright Agreement
- Conflict of Interest Statement

Incomplete submissions may be returned.

7. Submission Process

Manuscripts should be submitted through the official journal website or designated submission email.

Submission Steps:

1. Prepare manuscript according to guidelines
 2. Complete required forms
 3. Submit manuscript and documents
 4. Receive acknowledgement email
 5. Track review progress

8. Peer Review Process

All submissions undergo double-blind peer review.

- Identities of authors and reviewers are concealed
- At least two independent reviewers are assigned
- Review duration varies based on availability

Editorial decisions are final.

9. Revision and Resubmission

Authors must:

- Respond to reviewer comments point-by-point
- Submit revised manuscript within specified time
- Highlight changes where required

Failure to revise in time may result in rejection.

11. Article Processing Charges (APC)
